WHO CAN ATTEND—

- BHS Juniors and Seniors in good standing or a guest of a BHS Jr. or Sr. also in good standing. **GOOD STANDING** means: *no more than one F in the gradebook for 3^d quarter at time of purchase, no outstanding attendance issues with administration, no suspensions for second semester, and must have 30 service learning hours, if a junior or younger, and 40 service learning hours if a Senior.*
- ALL attendees must have a signed parent permission slip and dance contract before purchasing tickets.
- Guests from outside of BHS must be in high school, completed 8th grade, or a 2023 high school graduate. Guest Forms need to be signed by administration.

PROM COURT—

ALL Juniors attending prom will be on the ballot if they wish and **ONLY** Juniors will vote by electronic ballot. Prom Court consists of the top seven males & females with the most votes. If necessary, a second vote will decide King & Queen. Prom Court will be announced at the following times:
