Policy Title . . . BOARD ADVISORY COMMITTEE      Code No. 811.0

The Board may solicit volunteers to serve on Advisory Committees whose purpose shall be to promote and assist the Board in the improvement of quality and content of the School District's educational programs. They will have no official rights or powers but will serve in an advisory capacity to the Board and administration on matters of mutual concern and in addition serve as a communication link for feedback from students, parents, adults and community leaders.

Advisory committees may suggest, assist, assess or investigate the establishment or abandonment of procedural or academic plans and policies.

The committee will function at the will of the Board and follow Roberts Rules of Order. Minutes, roll call and formal agendas will be established by the chairperson and secretary with copies transmitted to all Board members and media and are subject to Wisconsin open meetings laws.
