Policy Title . . . COMPUTERS, DATA AND SOFTWARE Code No. 409.0

Computer is defined as an electronic device which performs logical, arithmetic and memory functions by manipulating electronic or magnetic impulses and includes all input, output, processing, storage, computer software and communication facilities which are connected or related to a computer system, network or instructional program.

It shall be the policy of the board to prosecute in civil action anyone who knowingly and wittingly without authorization of the board or its designee modifies data, computer programs or supporting documents, destroys data or programs, accesses data or programs, takes possession of data or programs or copies data, programs or supporting documents for any of the above.

It is further declared a policy of the board to file criminal charges against any person or persons who knowingly and wittingly modifies or destroys or steals computer equipment, supplies or systems which are or intended to be used in and for the Burlington Area School's programs or services.
