Policy Title . . . EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Code No. 370

The School Board believes that a dynamic program of student activities is vital to the complete development of the student. Such activities offer opportunities to serve the institution, to assist in development of fellowship and social goodwill, to promote self-realization and all around growth, and encourage the learning of qualities of good citizenship. Such programs shall include full participation of elementary students.

To assist in the administration of a student activities program, and to provide a framework of communication and review, a detailed structure of the activities program shall be developed by the administration and compiled in an operating procedures manual.

No person may be denied admission to any public school or be denied participation in, be denied the benefits of or be discriminated against in any curricular, extra curricular, pupil services, recreational or other program or activity because of the person's sex, sexual orientation, race, color, national origin, ancestry, religion, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, or any physical, mental, emotional or learning disability/handicap. Accordingly, the Board prohibits all forms of unlawful discrimination against students, regardless of the legally-protected classification or characteristic that serves as the basis for any prohibited discriminatory conduct, policy, or practice.

Complaints regarding the interpretation, enforcement, or alleged violations of this policy shall be referred to the administrative staff and processed in accordance with established procedures as outlined in School Board Policy 112.
