ADMINISTRATION REGULATIONS TITLE FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Code No. R-422.1

- American Field Service, Rotary International and International Student Exchange are the Burlington Area School Board approved providers of foreign exchange students.
- 2. Every effort will be made by May 1st of the preceding school year to notify the Burlington Area School District of the scheduled host families that are willing to host a student at Burlington High School.
- 3. Agencies will provide the high school principal, Superintendent, School Nurse and Director of Special Education with a profile of the student upon confirmation and prior to beginning school. This profile will include name, age, home country, host family information, immunization records and any special accommodations that may be needed in the school setting.
 - 4. Students will be scheduled in available courses but will not displace resident students from courses.
 - 5. The district will accept a maximum of six foreign exchange students per year.
