Policy Title . . . RESIDENT AND NONRESIDENT STUDENTS Code No. 422.0

1. Resident Student

Any child shall be considered a resident of the Burlington Area School District and shall be admitted to a district school if he/she:

- A. Is living in a home of his/her parent or legal guardian who resides within the boundaries of the district.
- B. Is living in a home of persons having custody and control which has been relinquished by the parents except if such residence has been established for the primary purpose of enabling the student to attend school in the district.
- C. Is a self supporting emancipated minor who has been so adjudged by a court of law.
- D. Is married and living with his/her spouse in the district.

2. Nonresident Student

- A. Nonresident students may be accepted as tuition students if approved by the School Board. Approval will be contingent upon space being available and the ability of staff to design an appropriate program. Tuition is set annually and a contract must be renewed each year.
- B. A student, whose parent has moved from the district, may complete the current year with tuition waived.
- C. A student who has attained twelfth grade status may complete his/her senior year with tuition being waived.
- D. A student, whose parents intend to move into the district prior to November 1, may have tuition waived during the first quarter only.
- E. Transportation will be the responsibility of the parent unless space on the bus is available on a previously established route.
- F. Nonresident students shall have all of the rights and privileges of resident students and shall be subject to the same rules and regulations.
- G. Nonresident students shall abide by WIAA eligibility rules for athletic participation.

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION TITLE
RESIDENT AND NONRESIDENT STUDENTS

Code No. R-422.0

Wisconsin State Statutes provides that only resident students be allowed to attend a public school free of tuition except as exempt by Board action under 121.81 and 121.84.

1. All registrations must include the residence of the student.
2. The parent or guardian of any student applying for admittance who does not reside in the school district must send a written request to the Board of Education stating
 - a. Their present address;
 - b. Any plans to move into our school district, including date of anticipated move;
 - c. What they are requesting of the School Board.
3. The action of the Board shall be reduced to writing.
 - a. If approved, a written agreement stating the terms of the admittance per Wisconsin Statute 121.81.
 - b. If denied, a letter from the Superintendent.
4. Copies of the agreement or letter will be sent to the principal of the school.
5. All tuition agreements must be approved by the State Superintendent according to provisions of Section 121.28.
