Policy Title . . . SECTION 504

Code No. 342.13

In accordance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, it is the policy of the Burlington Area School District to reasonably accommodate children who have a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more of the major life activities. The Superintendent shall appoint an administrator to serve as the 504 Coordinator and insure compliance with this policy and all administrative procedures related to this policy.

No otherwise qualified individual with disabilities shall, solely by reason of disability, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity. For purpose of this policy, a qualified individual with disabilities shall be one who satisfies the definition set forth in Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and its implementing regulation. The Burlington Area School District will identify, evaluate and provide a free appropriate public education as defined in Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 to qualified students with disabilities. The 504 Coordinator will insure due process rights will be offered to all students eligible for services.

The identification of students eligible for protection under 504 will be conducted at the building level. The Section 504 committee under the direction of the building administrator shall process referrals for students suspected of being disabled under Section 504.
