

BURLINGTON HIGH SCHOOL WALL OF INSPIRATION NOMINATION AND SELECTION INFORMATION

HOW ARE PEOPLE INFORMED AND NOMINATED FOR THE BURLINGTON WALL OF INSPIRATION?

1. The Wall of Inspiration Committee provides press releases requesting nominations from the community. There is a link on the Burlington High School web page with updated applications or they can be requested by calling 262-763-0200, Ext. 1008.
2. People in and outside of our community are encouraged to nominate a successful candidate.

WHAT IS THE NOMINATION CRITERIA?

In order to be nominated for Burlington High School's Wall of Inspiration, a person must meet three qualifications. They are:

1. The nominee must have attended Burlington High School.
2. The nominee must have attended Burlington High School at least 25 years earlier than the date of first application.
3. The nominee must have made noteworthy achievements and /or contributions to his/her chosen field or to humanitarian causes.
4. December 7th is the deadline for accepting nominations for the next recognition ceremony.
5. Nominees will be asked to fill out a questionnaire to return by January 4th.
6. Decisions will be made and selected candidates will be notified January 11th.
7. The recognition ceremony will be held on February 13th.

HOW ARE NOMINEES SELECTED FOR INDUCTION TO THE WALL OF INSPIRATION?

Not every person nominated can be selected for the Burlington High School Wall of Inspiration. A selection committee will be made up of 2 students, 2 former faculty members, 2 current faculty members, 2 community members, and 2 alumni. The committee reviews the nominations and biographical data received on each of the nominees, and, based on the committee's decisions, nominees are selected for induction. The selection process takes hours of reading, discussing, and reviewing before final selections are made. Nominees not selected for award status will automatically be included as a candidate for the next four years.
