Policy Title ... STATEMENT OF GUIDING PRINCIPLES Code No. 410

The School Board is committed to protect the rights of each student and promote the welfare of all students.

The right of a student to participate fully in classroom and extra curricular activities shall not be abridged or impaired on the basis of sex, sexual orientation, race, color, national origin, ancestry, religion, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, or any physical, mental, emotional or learning disability/handicap. Accordingly, the Board prohibits all forms of unlawful discrimination against students, regardless of the legally-protected classification or characteristic that serves as the basis for any prohibited discriminatory conduct, policy, or practice.

Policies in this series are enacted to aid in providing meaningful and relevant experiences for students in all activities related to the educational program. It is the purpose of the Board to provide opportunities for all students to become efficient, effective, productive and responsible human beings.

Complaints regarding the interpretation, enforcement, or alleged violations of this policy shall be referred to the administrative staff and processed in accordance with established procedures as outlined in School Board Policy 112.
