Policy Title . . . TOXIC AND INFECTIOUS SUBSTANCE Code No. 523.6
PROCEDURE

The district shall make every effort to give notice and warning to students and staff about known toxic or infectious agents, substances, or pesticides known or identified by the supplier, distributor or the Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations when present in the work place or building environment.

It shall also be the policy of the district to minimize the use of such substances whenever possible and offer to the employee a description of the symptoms and effects of these substances, directions on the safe handling procedures, and procedures for emergency treatment in the event of over-exposure.

It shall be the practice of the district to request from the aforementioned suppliers and distributors such information identified on the Material Safety Data Sheet as approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration when toxic or infectious substances are ordered.

The building administrator shall maintain a record of work related injuries which may have resulted from employee exposure to toxic materials and harmful physical agents which are required to be monitored.

The building administrator will post in a conspicuous place a summary of these protections and rights under the Wisconsin Statutes.
