### **Notes**

Clinics are open to those who do not have health insurance that covers vaccines and those who have Medicaid/BadgerCare (the Forward Card).

- DTaP, Tdap, Td, Polio, Hib, MMR, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis A, Chickenpox (varicella), Rotavirus, Pneumococcal Conjugate, HPV and Meningococcal are available at all clinic sites. Must bring written immunization record to be eligible for vaccination.
- TB skin testing is available at the Tuesday clinics. Must return in 48-72 hours to have the skin test read.
- Spanish interpreters are available at all clinics.
- There is a small administration fee, no charge for MA/BadgerCare recipients. No one is denied vaccine supplied by the State of Wisconsin for failure to pay.
- Children under age 18 must have a parent or legal guardian present or have written permission to be vaccinated.
