Option 1: Contact your doctor's office for an appointment.

- The health departments listed can only provide vaccines to individuals without medical insurance coverage or are underinsured (vaccines not covered by their medical insurance plan)
- Nurse vaccine visits are available as long as child is a current patient of the medical facility and is up to date on their physical (usually within the last year)
- Central Racine County Health Department Resident Municipalities Include: Caledonia, Dover, Mt. Pleasant, North Bay, Raymond, Rochester, Sturtevant, Union Grove, Yorkville, City and Town of Burlington, Village and Town of Waterford
- City of Racine Health Department Resident Municipalities Include: City of Racine, Wind Point, and Elmwood Park
