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4 EASY WAYS TO REGISTER

1.) INTERNET REGISTRATION

TO REGISTER ONLINE: Visit bit.ly/CEDOnlineRegistration. In the top right corner, click on "My Account". This will take you to the registration site for NEW and RETURNING users.

CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT: The first time you register, you will need to create an account for you and/or your family. A valid email address is required. If you have already registered for a program, but are unsure if you have an online account, please call 262-763-0219 prior to creating a new account.

LOG IN TO MY ACCOUNT: If you are a Returning User, log in to your Family Account and complete the checkout process. Please update family member information, including grade level, phone number, and email address, by going to the "Account Members Info" tab.

KNOW BEFORE YOU ENROLL....

Eligibility: Programs and services provided by the Community Education Department are open to all Burlington Area School District residents, as well as anyone living outside the Burlington Area School District.

Grade Level: Grade level refers to the “grade entering” in the 2024-2025 school year.

Register Early: Many classes fill quickly. Classes will be cancelled one week prior to the start date if sufficient enrollment is not received. Help us avoid the disappointment of class cancellations by registering early. Preregistration is essential so our instructors may plan accordingly.

Program Fees: All program fees are due at the time of registration.

Class Confirmation Emails: When you register online or mail/drop off a registration form, you will receive an email confirmation. Confirmation emails will include the date, time, and location of the class/camp. Please assume all classes/camps will be offered as scheduled unless you hear otherwise. It is very important that a valid email address is used when registering online or is listed on registration forms, as the majority of our communication is done via email.

Cancellation of a Class: Classes with insufficient enrollment will be cancelled, and payment will be refunded. Complete refunds will be given for any program cancelled by the Community Education Department.

Refunds: If you need to cancel a registration, please notify us at 262-763-0219 at least 3 working days prior to the scheduled start of an activity. No refunds will be given after the noted registration deadline. This policy is necessary for us to provide the best service to you and our instructors. We purchase supplies and commit to our instructors based on enrollment. If the department cancels or reschedules a program due to insufficient registration numbers, a full refund will be granted.

Minimum Enrollment: All programs are subject to cancellation if minimum enrollment is not met. When this is the case, preregistered participants will be contacted and receive a refund or credit to the account. We make every effort to avoid cancellations.

Correspondence: Please provide a valid email address and a daytime phone number on your registration form or when registering online. We will communicate with you regarding any changes to an activity you are registered for. We do the majority of our correspondence via email, so it is important to include a valid email if possible.

Photography: We use pictures of participants in Activity Guides and social media. We will not identify individuals by name. If you do not want a photo posted, please tell the photographer and/or instructor as well as the staff in the Community Education Department.

Activity Changes: Due to circumstances beyond our control, some activities may require time or location change. All participants will be notified via email and/or phone. It is important that accounts have an accurate email and/or phone number listed.

New Classes and Camps: Although we print only one Activity Guide per year, we are continually adding new classes and camps. We advertise and promote all classes and camps on Facebook and on the CED website. Please check here often so you don't miss out on great opportunities.

Non-Discrimination: We do not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, gender, national origin, age, or handicapped status.

Funding: Community Education is funded through Fund 80. These funds can only be used for community enrichment and recreation, as well as to share the school district's resources.

Safety Issues: We are devoted to conducting programs or activities in the safest manner possible. However, participants and parents registering their child in recreation programs must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities. The department strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions.

Weather Cancellations: If the Burlington Area School District is closed due to inclement weather, then all Burlington Community Education Department programs and activities are also cancelled.
