

SUMMER REC | BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES AND DISCIPLINE POLICY

Summer Rec campers are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times. We expect campers to act respectfully at all times and behave in a mature and responsible way. In order to provide all campers and staff with a camp experience that is safe and enjoyable, the following guidelines have been developed. A caring and positive approach will be taken regarding discipline, along with positive reinforcement. Inappropriate behavior will be addressed with firm statements and redirection. All campers must understand and follow the daily guidelines set forth. Please review these guidelines with your child.

BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES TO BE FOLLOWED:

- Be kind. Talk in a pleasant manner.
- Foul language, put downs, and bullying will not be accepted.
- Include all campers who would like to participate during “choice time” as well as during small and large group activities.
- Treat all equipment and supplies with proper care and respect. Clean up after yourself at all times.
- Show respect towards the staff and fellow campers, as well as school equipment and supplies.
- Have a positive attitude and have fun!

When a camper does not follow the behavior guidelines, staff will take the following action steps as behavior problems progress.

DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES

Step 1: A discreet verbal warning will be given. Staff will redirect the camper to more appropriate behavior.

Step 2: If inappropriate behavior continues, the camper will be given a ‘break’ from the group. During a ‘break’, a camper may have to sit out from activities, including: movie time, games, or group activities. Upon pick-up, Summer Rec staff will speak with the child and the parent/guardian regarding the behavior. Documented in behavior binder.

Step 3: If inappropriate behavior continues to be an ongoing issue, the parent/guardian will be notified and will be asked to pick up their child from Summer Rec. The CED Director, Assistant, and/or Summer Rec Supervisor will speak with the child and the parent/guardian upon pick up regarding the behavior and the possibility of having to find alternative arrangements for child care. Documented in behavior binder.

*** After following the progressive discipline procedures established, if behavior issues become a regular occurrence and continue to be a disruption to our climate, the child will not be permitted to attend Summer Rec.
