

Dear basketball players and parents,

Congratulations on making the choice to participate in basketball. Our season will begin on September 14th and conclude on October 27th. We are looking forward to a great season. Here are a few points you need to know about our program.

- We are SO excited to have a season this year. It may not quite look like our past seasons, but we will provide a fun experience with a chance to grow at the game of basketball as well as an overall athlete, teammate, and leader.
- Athletic Registration for Karcher Middle School will be completed online via Skyward for 2020/21. A current physical is also required to be on file with the Burlington High School athletic office.
- We will practice four days a week. Mondays and Fridays will be at Karcher Middle School from 3:20pm to 4:45pm. Tuesdays and Thursdays will be at Burlington High School from 2:45pm to 4:00pm. We will not practice on Wednesday.
- When we practice at Karcher, the girls will ride on Bus 3C, in Group 1, from the high school over to Karcher, right after school. Coaches will ensure the players get on the bus and will meet them upon arrival at Karcher.
- If parents are dropping off at Karcher, please do not drop off earlier than 3:15pm.
- Locker rooms will be available for girls to change into practice clothes.
- Girls are welcome to come to practice all 4 days of the week. However, we know that transportation may be an issue on days when a student is not in school. We understand this and will be very understanding. The girls should attend when they can but not feel ANY stress if they can't.
- We will not have a 'typical' conference game schedule as in years past, but we are hoping to be able to schedule a few games this season. If things work out - fingers crossed - they will be added to the calendar in place of practices.
- Girls do need to make sure they wear a mask on the bus and during practice. They also should make sure they have a water bottle.
- Above all, we are just so happy to be back in a gym setting with students. We will provide a meaningful, enjoyable experience for the girls. We look forward to working with them!
