Policy Title . . . GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES Code No. 161

The School Board shall make rules for its own government and that of the staff and students for the care of the buildings, grounds, and property of the school corporation, aid in the enforcement of these rules, and require the performance of duties of said persons imposed by the law and the rules.

Legislative: The School Board represents the people of the district and shall function as a policy-making body. The Board has complete jurisdiction over the school district and its employees.

Executive: The School Board selects an executive officer, the Superintendent of Schools, and delegates to the superintendent the authority for carrying out the policies, plans, and administrative details necessary to insure that all phases formulated by the Board are made effective in the operation of the schools.

Appraisal: Appraisal is that function which attempts, through careful examination and study of facts and conditions, to determine the efficiency of the operation of the schools, not only in dollars and cents, but in desirable values as the result of instruction based on a sound philosophy of education.
