Policy Title . . . HONORS AND AWARDS

Code No. 460

Any regularly enrolled student may be considered for honors or awards presented by the school. Qualifications for such awards shall be established by professional school personnel who have been delegated the responsibility by the Superintendent of Schools or the building principal.

The School District shall not discriminate in acceptance and administration of honors or awards based on sex, sexual orientation, race, color, national origin, ancestry, religion, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, or any physical, mental, emotional or learning disability/handicap. Accordingly, the Board prohibits all forms of unlawful discrimination against students, regardless of the legally-protected classification or characteristic that serves as the basis for any prohibited discriminatory conduct, policy, or practice.

Complaints regarding the interpretation, enforcement, or alleged violations of this policy shall be referred to the administrative staff and processed in accordance with established procedures as outlined in School Board Policy 112.
