Policy Title. . . INTERNET SAFETY ACCEPTABLE USE OF TECHNOLOGY
Code No. 363.2

The Burlington Area School District is providing employees and students with access to the District's electronic communication system (hereafter referred to as District System), which includes Internet access.

The District system has a limited educational purpose. The purpose of the District system is to assist in preparing students for success in life and work in the 21st century by providing them with electronic access to a wide range of information and the ability to communicate with people from throughout the world. Additionally, the system will be used to increase District intracommunication, enhance productivity, and assist District employees in upgrading their skills through greater exchange of information with their peers. The District system will also assist the District in sharing information with the local community, including parents, social service agencies, government agencies, and businesses.

The Superintendent or designee shall develop such administrative procedures, guidelines, and practices as necessary to insure that the purposes outlined in this policy may be achieved including procedures regarding the safe use of the internet by students.

The administrative procedures developed shall be communicated to all within the school community in order to insure acceptable and safe use of technology.
