Smoking and the use of tobacco related products by pupils is prohibited on school property or while under the supervision of the school, while at a school sponsored event, or anytime during the school day. Violation of this policy can result in suspension and parental conferences, and also comes under the jurisdiction of the Extra Curricular Code of Conduct.

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION TITLE
SMOKING

Code No. R-443.3

The no smoking rule is to be enforced.

1. Reasonable and prudent standards shall be used in enforcing the policy.
2. Smoking or use of tobacco related products is prohibited on field trips and any other event off campus where the Burlington Area School District is the primary sponsor and/or supervisor.
3. Students attending athletic or extra curricular events out of the district as spectators only come under the policies of the sponsoring district or institution.
4. Students violating the policy shall be dealt with in such a manner to encourage efforts to cease smoking.
