DPI Corrective Action Plan



Four requirements of DPI Corrective Action Case No. 20-PDA-02

- 1. Prevent further instances of discrimination in discipline
- 2. Adequately redress the racially hostile environment present in BASD
- Complete: Review its past reporting on discrimination complaints to ensure compliance with BASD policies and procedures and enact clear guidelines for future reporting; and
- 4. <u>Complete</u>: Review its policies and procedures to ensure they comply with the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

Requirement #1

Prevent further instances of discrimination in discipline.



As required by DPI, we are conducting a discipline audit. DPI suggested we contract with **Dan Losen**, **Director of Civil Rights at UCLA**.
