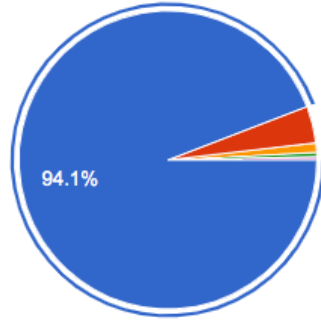

Describe how your student accessed the Internet during remote learning:



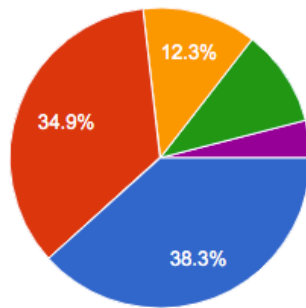

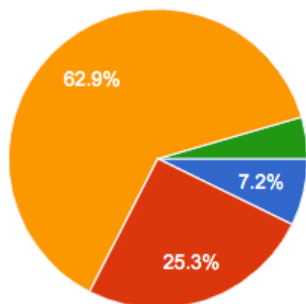

How did your student complete their schoolwork in a remote learning environment compared to in-person learning?



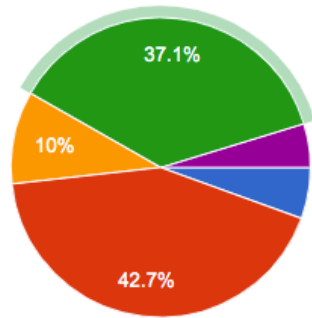

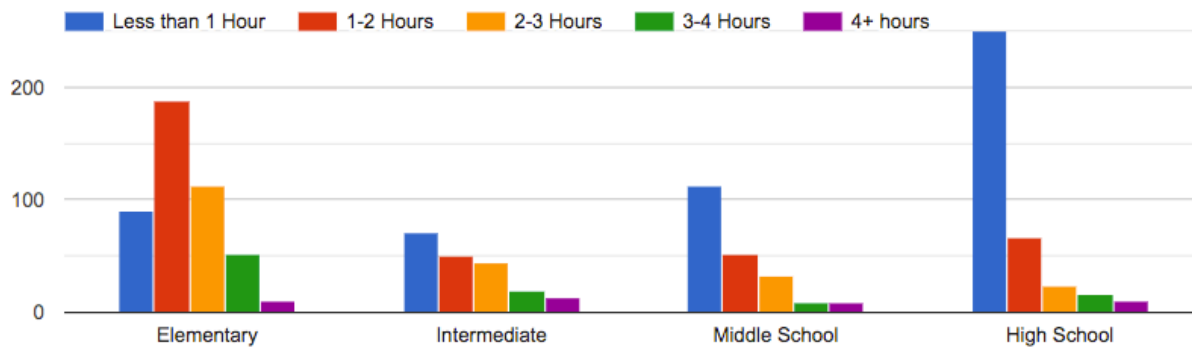
How did your child navigate the social/emotional challenges created by not attending school in person?

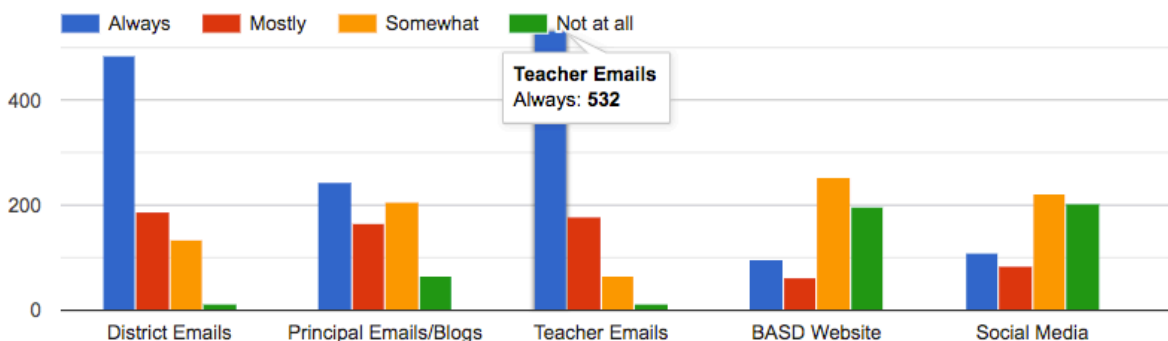


- Remote learning met my student's needs better than in-person learning

On average, how much time did you spend assisting your student/s with their schoolwork? (per day)



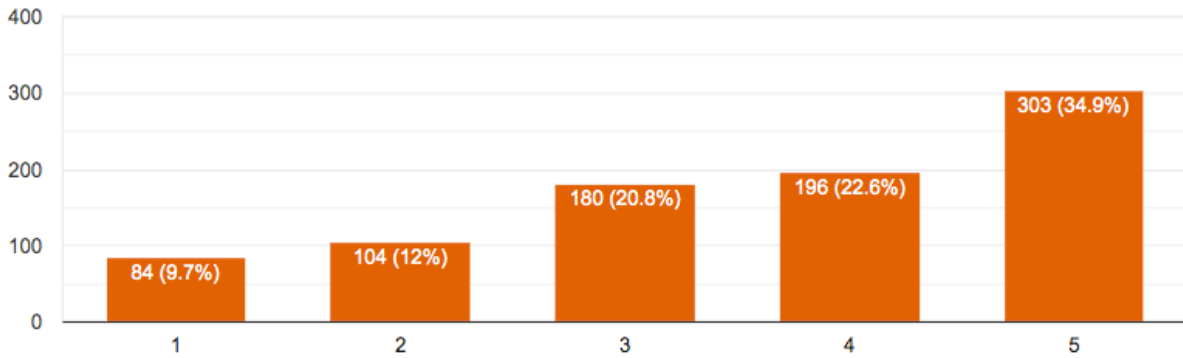

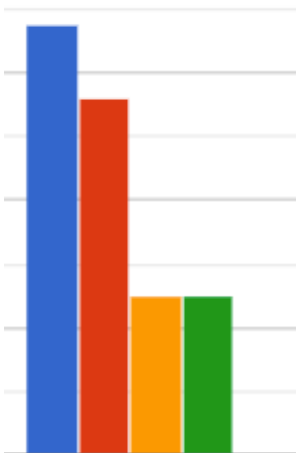
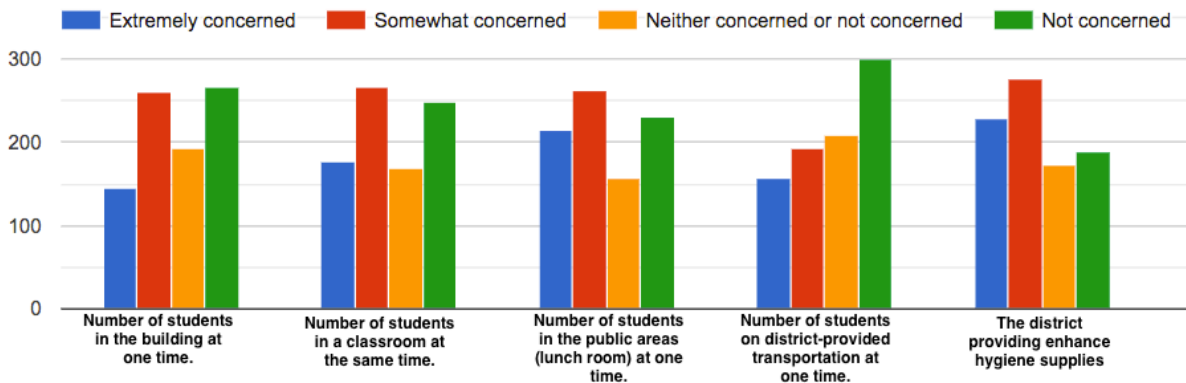
What is your comfort level in sending your student to school in-person in the fall?
