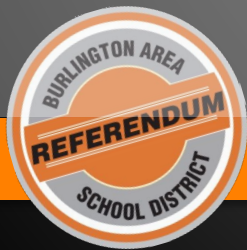
Redrawing District Boundaries

Burlington Area School District Referendum Update

Current vs. 2021

- Grade 5 moves from Intermediate to Elementary
- BASD moves from 4 to 5 Elementary Schools
- Enrollment of existing schools changes
 - Waller example
- Montessori enrollment is unchanged - total program will be at Dyer
