COURSE DESCRIPTION: Geometry will explore concepts such as: points, lines, planes, parallel & perpendicular lines, transformations, triangle congruence, properties of quadrilaterals, right triangle trigonometry, properties of circles, surface area & volume.

MATERIALS:

3-Ring Binder Notebook or Loose-Leaf Paper (lined or graph paper)

Pen or Pencil Scientific Calculator TI-30XIIS (cell phones are not allowed)

Charged Chrome Book

GRADING: Your grade will be based on your performance in several categories. Please understand that we *do not* give grades, you <u>earn</u> your grade. You earn your grade by demonstrating your mastery of the material. Your grade is based upon your ability to demonstrate your knowledge of the material. Please do not ask for extra credit at the end of a grading period. **There is NO rounded grades.**

The grade you earn in the Skyward is the grade you receive. Grades are computed in the following manner:

Assignments = *5 points

Activities (Khan Academy & Horizon) = *5-10 points

Tests = *100-200 points

Final Exam/Midterm = TBA points (10% of overall grade)

*Points are subject to change.

ASSIGNMENTS/HOMEWORK: Assignments are given almost every day. Just like any other skill, mathematics needs to be practiced. Assignments will be graded by any of the teachers in your Geometry class. Points will be awarded on the following scale:

- 0 less than 20% of the assignment is correct
- 1 20% of the assignment is correct
- 2 40% of the assignment is correct
- 3 60% of the assignment is correct
- 4 80% of the assignment is correct
- 5 100% of the assignment is correct

Corrections are allowed as long as completed in a timely fashion.

ACTIVITIES: Khan Academy and/or Horizon are an extension of assignments and provides immediate feedback. Points that are assigned will be available when assigned. The **Activities** category is open to more than Khan Academy and Horizon.

ASSESSMENTS: In order to retake an assessment, you must have all homework covered on the assessment completed. You may retake 2 tests per semester. This needs to be done **within one week or by date listed on white board** of receiving the original grade. After the time has lapsed, you will not be allowed to take a test. It is your responsibility to let us know in advance of completing a retake and to schedule a time to complete the retake outside of class time.

ABSENCES: *YOU* are responsible for any work that you miss. Please communicate any planned absences with us ahead of time.

EXTRA HELP: Sometimes math gets confusing. *PLEASE* do not be afraid to ask for help when you need it! Take responsibility for your learning! You are welcome to get extra help before school, after school, or during Monday, Wednesday, Friday Advisory. Please communicate with us when you plan to see one of your teachers for assistance!

CHEATING: Cheating is incredibly serious. At many universities, if you are caught cheating, you can be expelled. Therefore, please be responsible and do your own work. Working together on an assignment is always acceptable. However, copying someone else's work is not acceptable. **If you are caught cheating on an assignment, homework check, or test, you will receive a zero.**

CLASS EXPECTATIONS: Most rules are common sense and involve simply showing respect for yourself and others, but here is the short list:

- Please keep earbuds out unless it is work time. They are not allowed during tests or during a lesson.
- Each student will refrain from using his/her cell phone in class. Cell phones are required to be turned into the cell phone caddy daily. School policy states: No cell phones visible in the classroom (only allowed in hallways and cafeteria). Cell phone violation will result in cell phone being collected and returned: 1st offense end of hour, 2nd offense end of day, 3rd offense brought to office and parent must pick up
- Each student will refrain from using his/her Chrome Book unless instructed to do so.
