

FST 3-6 Warm up

1) The weights of a group of astronauts training for a mission to the Moon are in the table below.

Astronaut	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10
Weight (lb)	163	115	180	191	121	183	178	107	201	186

a) Find the mean weight and the standard deviation for this set of data.

$$\bar{x} : 162.5 \quad s_x : 34.76$$

b) The gravity on the moon is $\frac{1}{6}$ the gravity of Earth, so weights on the Moon are $\frac{1}{6}$ of weights on Earth. Give the mean weight and standard deviation of this group of astronauts on the Moon.

$$\bar{x} : 27.08\bar{3} \quad s_x : 5.793$$

c) How will the median, the first quartile, and the range of the data be affected by the transformation in Part b.

They will all change by $\frac{1}{6}$.

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
