## **Safety Expectation**

## **Technology Expectations**

### **No Cell Phone Policy**

Students will **NOT** be allowed to have cell phones with them while they are in my classroom, unless they have been given permission. If a student chooses to bring their phone with them to class, they will be required to place their phone in the designated cell phone area. **1<sup>st</sup> Offense**: Your phone is taken away until the end of the hour. **2<sup>nd</sup> Offense**: Your phone is taken away until the end of the school day. **3<sup>rd</sup> Offense**: Your phone is taken away and brought to the office. Your parents will need to come and pick up your phone.

### **Charged Chromebook Requirement**

Students are required to bring their **CHARGED CHROMEBOOKS** to class with them everyday. The library will only be issuing loaners for students whose chromebooks are not working properly. You will receive a zero for any daily activity that you are unable to complete due to not having your chromebook with you.

### **Calculator Requirement**

In order to be successful in this course, you will need a scientific calculator. The recommended scientific calculator is a TI-30X II. We recommend this calculator as it operates very much the same as the TI graphing calculators. A graphing calculator will meet the requirement for this course as well. You will **NOT** be allowed to use your cell phone as a calculator.
