Access to Buildings

Please be reminded that families can pick up items that were left at school that their child needs between the hours of 8:00 am - 4:00 pm through the end of the day tomorrow, Tuesday, March 17th. After that, our buildings will be closed.

What does virtual learning look like?

Virtual Learning will look different at every learning level. Teachers will keep students engaged and productive, while also keeping expectations reasonable. All the work doesn't need to be completed in one day. Do what you can, as you can. As an example, we've heard that some families have created a schedule for their day with designated learning time. For some families, that may be at 10 am, another family it may be at 6 pm. Others may choose to have their learning time on the weekend. Don't let this stress you out.

Meal Service

Please understand that the requirements we've specified, such as having the child present to receive a meal, are those established by the United States Department of Agriculture Food and Nutrition Service.

This includes ALL participation including, but not limited to training, practices, scrimmages, and contests. Coaches may provide individual workouts virtually, but shall not encourage or organize their team assembling to practice.
